



Mosaic Sampler CAL - week two

Welcome to the second pattern of the Mosaic Sampler CAL. I hope you enjoyed last weeks pattern and can't wait to get started with this second design.



Pattern two:

This week the pattern is quite geometrical and is made up of three blocks of colour. The patterns in block one and three are identical and block two is offset by six stitches.

The first block of the pattern has 11 rows because the white row separating patterns one and two is also part of the row count for this first block.

This is a slightly more challenging pattern this week as there are a lot more drop trebles and each row is completely different from the row below.

Row 13 of the last colour block will be the row which separates pattern two from pattern three.

TIPS:

- I always tick each row off as I finish it. This way I know I won't accidentally crochet it again.
- I always check that my stitch count after the final treble matches the stitch count on the end section of the chart as this way I can see immediately if I have made any errors on the row just done.
- if you are new to crochet you may find it easier to tick off the stitches as well as the rows in the first repetition of the pattern.

NOTES for video:



- I use UK crochet terms throughout.
- I may refer to the double crochet into the back loop as double crochet.
- I may refer to the treble stitch into the front loop two rows below as a drop treble.
