



Mosaic Sampler CAL - week seven

Welcome to the seventh and last pattern of the central part of the Mosaic Sampler CAL. I do hope you have been having fun with the patterns.



Pattern seven:

This last pattern is a mirror image of pattern one and the colours have been flipped so that you will end with the same colour that you started with back in pattern one. This is an easy and familiar pattern for you to end this middle section of the mosaic sampler with.

Row thirteen mimics the chain stitch row way back at the beginning of your mosaic sampler and is done this way so that the border edges at the top and bottom look symmetrical.

In row thirteen you are working from the back side of the afghan and starting at the right hand side and with colour A, work one chain into the border stitch of the previous row and then slip stitch into the back loop all the way along until the last border stitch of the previous row.

TIPS:

- I always tick each row off as I finish it. This way I know I won't accidentally crochet it again.
- I always check that my stitch count after the final treble matches the stitch count on the end section of the chart as this way I can see immediately if I have made any errors on the row just done.

NOTES for video:

- I use UK crochet terms throughout.
- I may refer to the double crochet into the back loop as double crochet.
- I may refer to the treble stitch into the front loop two rows below as a drop treble.
